Abstract On December 7, 2006, a 25-year-old male volunteer fire  
fighter responded to a restaurant fire. On-scene, the  
fire fighter helped remove part of a wall to access  
burning wires. Units returned to their station one hour  
later, and the fire fighter returned home for the  
evening. At 0111 hours on the next morning (December  
8th), the fire department was dispatched to a residence  
for a gas odor. The fire fighter's roommates responded  
to the call, but he did not. Thinking the fire fighter  
had slept in, the roommates did not check on him when  
they returned home at approximately 0145 hours. The  
roommates left for work later in the morning, but the  
fire fighter still had not risen. When a roommate  
returned home at approximately 1840 hours, he and the

fire fighter's girlfriend entered the house and the fire fighter's room and found him unresponsive. An ambulance and police were summoned, but the fire fighter was dead.

The deputy coroner was notified and pronounced the fire fighter dead. The death certificate and autopsy (completed by the forensic pathologist) listed "sudden unexplained death in epilepsy" as the cause of death. NIOSH investigators offer the following recommendations to address general safety and health issues. If the fire company had implemented the following recommendations, perhaps the annual medical evaluation would have resulted in better medical compliance of his anti-seizure medication, and thus his death may have been prevented at this time. (1) Perform pre-placement and periodic medical evaluations consistent with National Fire Protection Association (NFPA) 1582, Standard on Comprehensive Occupational Medical Program for fire departments. (2) Ensure that fire fighters are cleared for duty by a physician knowledgeable about the physical demands of fire fighting, the personal protective equipment used by fire fighters, and the various components of NFPA 1582. (3) Provide fire fighters with medical evaluations and clearance to wear self-contained breathing apparatus (SCBAs). (4) Develop a structured wellness/fitness program for fire fighters to reduce risk factors for cardiovascular disease and improve cardiovascular capacity.

Abstract Much of the current perception of earthquakes in the United States has been shaped by knowledge of the earthquake hazard, which focuses on the location and type of faulting and ground failure, and the distribution of strong ground motion, or shaking. Earthquake hazard databases and maps - produced by the U.S. Geological Survey (USGS), state geological surveys and other research institutions - provide consistent and useful data. While hazard maps contribute to understanding earthquakes, there is increasing

recognition among policy makers, researchers and practitioners of the need to analyze and map the earthquake risk in the United States. As urban development continues in earthquake prone regions there is growing concern about the exposure of buildings, lifelines (e.g. utilities and transportation systems), and people to the potential effects of destructive earthquakes. Earthquake risk analysis begins with hazard identification, but goes beyond that to investigate the potential consequences to people and property, including buildings, lifelines, and the environment. Risk analysis is useful for communities, regions, and the nation in making better decisions and setting priorities. The ability to compare risk across states and regions is critical to the management of the National Earthquake Hazards Reduction Program (NEHRP). At the state and community level, an understanding of seismic risk is important for planning, evaluating costs and benefits associated with building codes, and other prevention measures. An understanding of earthquake risk is important to risk management for businesses and industries, as well. And, understanding the consequences of earthquakes is critical to developing emergency operations plans for catastrophes. This study uses Hazards U.S. Multi-hazard (HAZUS-MH) Version MR2, a PC-based standardized tool that uses a uniform engineering-based approach to measure damages, casualties and economic losses from earthquakes nationwide. HAZUS®-MH MR2 was released by FEMA in 2006 and incorporates updates to the building valuation data and enhanced loss estimation functions. Appendix B contains a detailed discussion of HAZUS-MH MR2.

Abstract The Environmental Protection Agency's (EPA) mission includes evaluating and regulating toxic chemicals. EPA's Integrated Risk Information System (IRIS) program is a chemical evaluation program that is a critical component of EPA's capacity to support scientifically sound environmental regulations and policies. The IRIS database contains EPA's scientific position on the potential human health effects of exposure to more than 540 chemicals. This testimony highlights GAO's work on toxic substances, focusing on (1) its March 2008 report, Chemical Assessments: Low Productivity and New Interagency Review Process Limit the Usefulness and Credibility of EPA's Integrated Risk Information System and (2) key changes to the IRIS assessment process EPA included in its revised IRIS assessment process released on April 10, 2008. It also highlights the findings of two GAO reports on EPA's regulation of toxic chemicals. For the IRIS report, GAO analyzed EPA data and interviewed officials at relevant agencies, including the Office of Management and Budget (OMB). For this testimony, GAO supplemented the IRIS report with a review of EPA's revised IRIS assessment process announced earlier this month. Given the importance of the IRIS program to EPA's ability to protect public health and the environment, Congress should consider requiring EPA to suspend its new process and develop one that is responsive to GAO's recommendations. The IRIS database is at serious risk of becoming obsolete because EPA has not been able to routinely complete timely, credible assessments or decrease its backlog of 70 ongoing assessments--a total of 4 were completed in fiscal years 2006 and 2007. In addition, recent assessment process changes, as well as other changes EPA was considering at the time of GAO's review, further reduce the timeliness and credibility of IRIS assessments. Although EPA has taken steps to improve the IRIS program since 2000 and has developed a number of draft assessments for external review, its efforts to finalize assessments have been thwarted by a combination of factors, including two new OMB-required reviews of

IRIS assessments by OMB and other federal agencies; EPA management decisions, such as delaying some assessments to await new research; and the compounding effect of delays--even one delay can have a domino effect, requiring the process to essentially be repeated to incorporate changing science and methods. The OMB/interagency reviews of draft assessments involve other federal agencies in EPA's IRIS assessment process in a manner that limits the credibility of IRIS assessments and hinders EPA's ability to manage them. For example, the OMB/interagency reviews lack transparency, and OMB required EPA to terminate five assessments EPA had initiated to help it implement the Clean Air Act. The changes to the IRIS assessment process that EPA was considering, but had not yet issued at the time of GAO's review, would have added to the already unacceptable level of delays in completing IRIS assessments and further limited the credibility of the assessments. On April 10, 2008, EPA issued a revised IRIS assessment process, effective immediately. In its February 2008 comments on GAO's draft report, EPA said it would consider the report's recommendations, which were aimed at streamlining the process and better ensuring that EPA has the ability to develop transparent, credible assessments. However, EPA's new process is largely the same as the draft GAO evaluated, and some key changes also are likely to further exacerbate the productivity and credibility concerns GAO identified. For example, while the draft process would have made comments on IRIS assessments from other federal agencies part of the public record, EPA's new process expressly defines such comments as "deliberative" and excludes them from the public record.

GAO continues to believe it is critical that input from all parties--particularly agencies that may be affected by the outcome of IRIS assessments--be publicly available. As recommended in GAO's March 2008 report, to effectively maintain IRIS, EPA must, among other things, streamline its lengthy assessment process and adopt transparency practices that provide assurance that IRIS assessments are appropriately based on the best available science and that they are not inappropriately biased by policy considerations. Since EPA's new process is not responsive to GAO's recommendations, the viability of this critical database has been further jeopardized.

The NRF details the responsibilities of supporting federal agencies, including the Department of Transportation (DOT), whose responsibilities include coordinating the restoration and recovery of transportation systems and infrastructure, and the Department of Health and Human Services (HHS), whose responsibilities include coordinating public health and medical services. The federal government can provide medical resources, such as emergency medical care and the evacuation of hospital patients during disasters, through the National Disaster Medical System (NDMS), a partnership of DHS, the Department of Defense, the Department of Veterans Affairs, and HHS. Recently, Congress expressed concerns about the extent to which GAO's recommendations have been implemented and asked us to assess the progress these agencies have made in doing so. GAO found that

Abstract Forty million people died when the last major influenza pandemic swept around the world in 1918. We have seen two less severe pandemics since then. We will no doubt see another sometime in the future. We don't know when, and we don't know how bad it will be. But we know it will happen sooner or later and that what we do now will save lives - maybe millions of lives - in the future. We have come a long way since November 2005, when President Bush mobilized the nation to prepare for an influenza pandemic. HHS continues to play a prominent role in pandemic preparedness, giving highest priority to those tasks that it is best positioned or uniquely able to undertake. These include: (1) stockpiling pre-pandemic vaccine and antiviral drugs; (2) providing financial and technical assistance to States to help them, among other things, create complementary stockpiles of antiviral drugs and develop and test various mitigation strategies; (3) creating a domestic vaccine production capacity commensurate with the expected requirements of a pandemic; and (4) sponsoring advanced development projects toward the next generation of vaccines, therapeutics, and diagnostics. In our last Update, we mentioned many of the important milestones we have passed already. We have licensed the first H5N1 influenza vaccine for humans and stockpiled enough antiviral medicine to treat 40 million Americans. We have committed over \$1 billion to diversify influenza vaccine production technology. And we have worked with the world's leading vaccine companies to accelerate the development of cell-based influenza vaccine production to increase the nation's domestic vaccine production capacity. We have also invested heavily in clinical research and surveillance programs here at home and

around the world. We have held flu summits in every State of the Union, plus our first on-line "blog summit" last June. We have organized, equipped, and trained response teams and begun to modernize the U.S. Public Health Service Commissioned Corps to enhance its response capabilities. Since our last Update, we have entered a new phase in our preparations. The milestones are farther apart but no less significant. We are now tackling some challenging issues that can only be resolved with the collaboration of the full range of stakeholders - State and local officials, public health and medical professionals, religious leaders and ethicists, the business community, organized labor, non-governmental organizations, and individuals from all walks of life. Each is needed to find the best answers to difficult questions such as "How do we decide who receives the first vaccines from our limited supplies?" and "Who should be responsible for stockpiling medical countermeasures such as facemasks, respirators, ventilators, and antiviral medications?" We don't know if the H5N1 virus will spark the next pandemic, but we know that it's just a matter of time before something does. There is simply no reason to believe that this century will be different than any past century. The difference now is that we better understand the threat, so we can increase our preparedness for a pandemic before it comes, in order to diminish its potential impact. The Federal government cannot mount an effective response to the threats that we face as a nation without partners at every level of government and throughout society. It is every American's continued commitment that will make our country a safer and a healthier place.

Abstract On September 16, 2006, a 19-year-old male volunteer Fire Fighter (FF) participated in a parade and an automobile extrication demonstration, which included wearing full bunker gear and cutting into an automobile with heavy hydraulic rescue tools. During the demonstration, the FF complained of not feeling well,

passed the tool to a crew member, and collapsed. Crew members and on-scene ambulance paramedics began cardiopulmonary resuscitation (CPR) and advanced life support as they transported the FF to the hospital's Emergency Department. Inside the Emergency Department, despite advanced life support treatment for 13 minutes, the FF died. The death certificate and autopsy (completed by the Medical Examiner) listed "acute cardiac arrhythmia due to dilated cardiomyopathy associated with acute hemorrhage of the membranous septum of the heart" as the cause of death. It is unclear if the FF's sudden cardiac death was triggered by the physical exertion associated with the extrication demonstration. The following recommendations probably would not have prevented this fire fighter's death. However, NIOSH investigators offer these recommendations to address general safety and health issues: (1) Perform pre-placement and periodic medical evaluations consistent with National Fire Protection Association (NFPA) 1582, Standard on Comprehensive Occupational Medical Program for Fire Departments; (2) Ensure that fire fighters are cleared for duty by a physician knowledgeable about the physical demands of firefighting, the personal protective equipment used by fire fighters, and the various components of NFPA 1582; (3) Develop a structured wellness/fitness program for fire fighters to reduce risk factors for cardiovascular disease and improve cardiovascular capacity; and (4) Provide fire fighters with medical evaluations and clearance to wear self-contained breathing apparatus (SCBAs).

Abstract The Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) is the federal agency responsible for leading the Nation's efforts to prepare for, protect and mitigate against, respond to, and recover from the impacts of natural disasters and man-made incidents or terrorist events. FEMA's formation in 1979 by a Presidential executive order directed the combination of federal programs that addressed emergency management for all types of incidents into a single agency. As part of the Department of Homeland Security (DHS), FEMA works closely with many partners to prevent or limit the impacts of major disasters and emergencies on the Nation, now responding to an average of approximately 60 disasters per year. For example, FEMA has led successful responses to large disasters and incidents such as the Midwest floods of 1993 and 1997, the September 11, 2001, terrorist attacks, and the successive 2004 Florida hurricanes. However, the unprecedented 2005 hurricane season, which included hurricanes Katrina and Rita, demonstrated the need for nationwide changes for all of those involved with emergency management. Furthermore, the October 2006 passage of the Post-Katrina Emergency Management Reform Act (PKEMRA), part of the Fiscal Year 2007 Homeland Security Appropriations Act (P.L. 109-295), redefined FEMA, strengthened its roles, and included the integration of a robust national preparedness mission. As a result of these events FEMA's leadership began to

chart a new vision and direction for the agency. FEMA closely reviewed the lessons learned from the 2005 hurricane season and evaluated the agency's core missions, organizational structure, and internal systems and procedures. In October 2006 and August 2007, the Administrator held agency-wide conferences with the entire senior leadership to look forward and develop a new vision and the core competencies to support it. FEMA's vision is to transform the agency into the Nation's Preeminent Emergency Management and Preparedness Agency - the New FEMA. FEMA will rely on the following key building blocks to achieve this vision: (1) Strengthening core competencies, (2) Building strong regions, (3) Enhancing current partnerships and creating new ones, (4) Investing in its people, (5) Developing a business approach to achieving desired results, and (6) Professionalizing the national emergency management system. As the agency strives to become the Nation's Preeminent Emergency Management and Preparedness Agency, FEMA will work with all of its partners, federal agencies, states, territories, tribal nations, local governments, first responders, business and industry, and individuals to build a Nation that is most prepared, and one that is more capable, to respond and recover when disaster strikes.
